Hampden Estate HLCF Classic is a unique and exceptional rum. Made solely from the HLCF mark, it is the perfect bottle for connoisseurs and purists who enjoy intense and uncompromising tasting experiences.

Product description

Hampden Estate is known for producing a large variety of distillates.

Hampden HLCF Classic is a single mark, and a great introduction to the world of high esters rums.

HLCF stands for Hampden Light Continental Flavoured. It is one of several marks made at Hampden Estate and refers to a rum with a high ester concentration, ranging from 400 to 600 gr/HLPA.

This rum is marked by its power as shown by the 60% alcohol content. In spite of its strength, it remains refined and delicate, with toasty, woody and spicy aromas.

Tasting notes

Profile: Exuberant and elaborate.

Nose: Lively and concentrated. Acetone, roasted banana, prune, lemon and menthol notes.

Palate: Intense and exquisite. Bitter orange, candied cherry, smoked and roasted notes.

Finish: Extended and delicate. Pine resin, cooked cane syrup and herbaceous notes.

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
